Facilities include electric hook-ups, free showers and toilets, laundry equipment, dish washing and ice pack facilities.

Where we are

The Farm and touring park is situated on the Roseland Peninsula, which is on the South coast of Cornwall within an area of outstanding natural beauty.

The Villages of St. Mawes, Gerrans and Portscatho are minutes away. Falmouth, St. Austell and the Eden Project are a short journey away as is the City of Truro.



Directions

M5 to Exeter
Take the A30 from Exeter to Cornwall.
Leave the A30 at Innis Downs. At roundabout, take 1st exit onto A391 to St. Austell.
From St Austell take the A390 towards Truro.
Bear left on the B3287 to Tregony.
From Tregony follow the signs for St Mawes for 7 miles to Trewithian.
Turn left at the sign for Gerrans, Portscatho, Trewince Manor etc.
Stay on this road, following signs for St Anthony, to Trewince Farm one mile beyond Gerrans village.
